

What can you store?

Well, just about anything! So long as it's not living, flammable, toxic, noxious or perishable. Our customers store everything including:

- Household furniture, including carpets, curtains, cushions etc
- Family heirlooms and paintings
- Sports equipment and children's toys
- Garden accessories (tables, chairs, gardening tools)
- Spare clothes and / or bed linen
- Crockery and / or other kitchen items
- Electronic equipment (stereo, TV / dvd, computers etc..)
- Dry foodstuffs

Well, as we said, just about any manner of personal belongings! Some customers access their units once every six months, others almost daily; there's no limit or charge for the number of times you can access your own personal storage unit.



Insurance

We appreciate the importance of protecting your personal belongings in the event that the unthinkable might happen. We therefore ensure that all our customers are properly insured, and we will cover you under our own "AtticSafe" insurance policy.



What to bring with you

Before you come and see us please remember the following points:

- We only accept debit and credit cards (cheques with guarantee card)
- You will need to bring a photo ID (passport or drivers licence) AND 2 proofs of address (bank statement, council tax bill, utility bill etc) with you
- We will ask you to describe the goods that you are moving in to your room, and the value of these goods for insurance purposes
- When moving in for the first time, please do allow enough time before closing (1hr) to complete your storage licence & for us to show you how to gain access out of hours
- You will be closely monitored by our digital CCTV systems whilst on site, including remote monitoring with audio warnings
- While the units all possess individual alarms, the final layer of security is your own padlock and key. We offer a choice of approved new padlocks in store
- Please give us a name, address and telephone number for emergency contact - this must be a different address to your own

How long will it all take?

Check-in usually takes around 15-20 minutes, including confirming the actual unit, completing the licence agreement and showing you how our access control systems work. Our staff is fully trained and professional, and will provide you with all the help you need on move-in day.

How long can I store for?

Stay as long as you like - there is no maximum stay. The minimum storage period is 7 days.
